"I'll Push You"

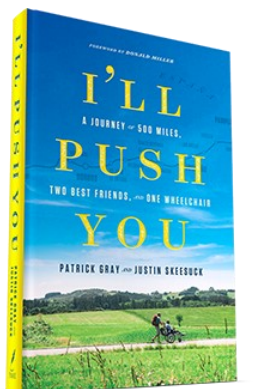
The Edith B. Siegrist Vermillion Public Library and the Vermillion Downtown Cultural Association are partnering to bring an inspirational new documentary to the Coyote Twin Theatre for a free one-night showing.

'I'll Push You' is an up-close and personal look into the dynamics of a life-long friendship between two best friends – Justin Skeesuck and Patrick Gray – as they travel across El Camino de Santiago. This feature-length documentary covers the struggle of the 35-day, 500-mile wheelchair journey across mountains, deserts, hills, and valleys and features perspectives from family and friends. Even though the story begins with the challenge that comes with Patrick's willingness to push Justin in a wheelchair across northern Spain, 'I'll Push You' also explores the struggles related to Justin's rare neurological disease. The parallel paths of Patrick's experience in Spain and Justin's life journey come together in a singular moment to reveal their similarities where Patrick discovers he's both the pusher and the pushed. The story's beautiful cinematography is set to poignant music tracks which perfectly underscores the inspiring example of love, vulnerability and community.

The documentary event begins at **7:00 pm on Monday, March 5th** at the Coyote Twin Theatre's RED Auditorium.

A discussion of the book will follow on **Monday, March 12th, at 7:00 pm** at the Vermillion Public Library. Copies of the book can be checked out now by visiting the Library's Circulation Desk, or by calling for more information: 605.677.7060.

Human Library Coming Soon!

Everyone has a story. What's yours? Share it at the Human Library!

Partnering with University Libraries, USD, the Edith B. Siegrist Vermillion Public Library is seeking “books” for the Human Library, to be held here at the Public Library on **Saturday, April 28th, from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm.**

Founded in 2001 in Denmark, the Human Library organization seeks to promote human rights and social cohesion by creating greater understanding between people. It provides an opportunity for people to learn more about each other while working through stereotypes and discrimination. A Human Library consists of volunteers who act as “books” that can be “checked out” by “readers.” Each book decides on a title that gives a snapshot of their story: “Buddhist,” “First Generation College Student,” or “Recovering Alcoholic,” for instance. The book and reader engage in a 20-minute one-on-one conversation about the book's life and experience; the book can ask questions of the reader as well, prompting discussion about shared experiences and differing perspectives. Individuals with stories they would like to share and discuss with others are encouraged to volunteer! Apply online to be a book at www.bit.ly/USDhuman.
